Warnings



NARNING: If you are younger than 18, do not use this.

You should go to a doctor, preferably an ear-nose-throat doctor (an ENT), because your condition needs specialized care. Over-the-counter hearing aids are only for users who are age 18 or older.

This OTC hearing aid is for users who are 18 and older. People who are younger than 18 with hearing loss should see a doctor, preferably an ENT, because they may need medical testing and management. Hearing loss can affect speech and learning, so professional fitting and continuing care are also important.



WARNING: When to See a Doctor

Your ear feels painful or uncomfortable.

If you have any of the problems listed below, please see a doctor, preferably an ear-nose-throat doctor (an ENT).

- · Your ear has a birth defect or an unusual shape. Your ear was injured or deformed in an accident.
- You saw blood, pus, or fluid coming out of your ear in the past 6 months.
- You have a lot of ear wax, or you think something could be in your ear.
- You get really dizzy or have a feeling of spinning or swaying (called vertigo).

- Your hearing changed suddenly in the past 6 months.
- Your hearing changes: it gets worse then gets better again.
- You have worse hearing in one ear.
- You hear ringing or buzzing in only one ear.



WARNING: This hearing aid should not cause pain when inserting it.

Remove this device from your ear if it causes pain or discomfort when you insert or place it. To try again, make sure to follow the instructions. If you feel pain or discomfort again, contact the manufacturer. If your pain or discomfort doesn't go away, contact your hearing healthcare professional. You can also report this to FDA as an adverse event according to the instructions that appear later.



WARNING: You have active implantable devices.

If you have active implantable devices (such as a pacemaker), keep magnets (charging base) at least 6 inches away from the active implant. Tweak recommends you always follow the guidelines of the implant manufacturer. If you suspect any interference to your implant, immediately discontinue use of electronic

devices, including hearing aids. Contact implant manufacturer and Tweak Hearing to report the suspected interference.



WARNING: Electromagnetic testing

Prior to any CT, MRI scans or other electromagnetic procedure, remove your hearing aids.



Caution: This is not hearing protection.

You should remove this device if you experience overly loud sounds, whether short or long-lasting. If you're in a loud place, you should use the right kind of hearing protection instead of wearing this device. In general, if you would use ear plugs in a loud place, you should remove this device and use ear plugs.



🗘 Caution: The sound output should not be uncomfortable or painful.

You should turn down the volume or remove the device if the sound output is uncomfortably loud or painful. If you consistently need to turn the volume down, you may need to further adjust your device.



Caution: You might need medical help if a piece gets stuck in your ear.

If any part of your hearing aid, like the eartip, gets stuck in your ear, and you can't easily remove it with your fingers, get medical help as soon as you can. You should not try to use tweezers or cotton swabs because they can push the part farther into your ear, injuring your eardrum or ear canal, possibly seriously.



If you try this device and continue to struggle with or remain concerned about your hearing, you should consult with a hearing healthcare professional.

Also if you experience side effects from wearing the hearing aids, contact a hearing healthcare professional. Possible side effects may be: dizziness, tinnitus, perceived worsening of hearing loss, nausea, headache, skin reaction, or excessive ear wax accumulation.

i Note: What you might expect when you start using a hearing aid

A hearing aid can benefit many people with hearing loss. However, you should know it will not restore normal hearing, and you may still have some difficulty hearing over noise. Further, a hearing aid will not prevent or improve a medical condition that causes hearing loss.

People who start using hearing aids sometimes need a few weeks to get used to them. Similarly, many people find that training or counseling can help them get more out of their devices.

If you have hearing loss in both ears, you might get more benefit from using hearing aids in both, especially in situations that make you tired from listening—for example, noisy environments.

i Note: Tell FDA about injuries, malfunctions, or other adverse events.

To report a problem involving your hearing aid, you should submit information to FDA as soon as possible after the problem. FDA calls them "adverse events," and they might include: skin irritation in your ear, injury from the device (like cuts or scratches, or burns from an overheated battery), pieces of the device getting stuck in your ear, suddenly worsening hearing loss from using the device, etc.

Tweak Enhance OTC hearing aids are intended to address perceived mild-to-moderate hearing loss in people aged 18 or older.


Indications for Use



introduction

Tweak Enhance is a rechargeable OTC hearing aid. You'll discover Tweak Enhance is like having four hearing aids in your ear.

The hearing aid has four listening modes:

Conversation, Restaurant, Traffic, and Outdoor.



charging information


Tweak Enhance is powered by a lithium polymer battery that is rechargeable. It's best to charge your hearing aid completely prior to each use.

When not in use, turn off the hearing aid to prevent unnecessary battery drain or leave it in the charging base. See page 46 for instructions on turning power on/off.

Enhance hearing aids have a nonremovable lithium-polymer battery. Your hearing aids can be taken onto airplanes in carry-on luggage.

Time to fully charge Approximately 3 hours		
Battery life of full charge	Approximately 20 hours Keep in mind some functions of the hearing aid (volume level, noise compression, etc.) require more energy than others. You may find the battery needs recharging sooner than 20 hours.	

1 Tweak Enhance comes with a charging base, power block and power cable. The cable provided has a USB-C connector on one end that plugs into the charging base.



The charging base is marked with blue and red circles. Place each instrument in the correct port. Match the colored text on the sound tube with the correct port.

Fully charge Tweak Enhance before proceeding to setup. The hearing aid battery will be fully charged in about 3 hours. Leaving the device in the charging base will not damage the battery. It will not overcharge.





The lithium polymer battery should not be removed by the user. The battery must be replaced by the manufacturer. Call 1-888-815-3240 for assistance.

Place the hearing aid in the charging base. If the hearing aid is on, it will shut off automatically when placed in the charger. The rocker switch will glow blue while charging. When fully charged, the rocker switch will glow green.

Voltage Status Indicator



red light on base fault in the instrument, base, cable or adapter Call 1-888-815-3240 for assistance.

low battery warning

Once the voltage drops to 3.45V, you will hear three beeps every 4 minutes, which indicates it's time to charge the hearing aid.


When the battery voltage falls to 3.12V, Tweak will automatically shut down. Charge the hearing aid immediately.



The battery life of a full charge is approximately 20 hours

Keep in mind some functions of the hearing aid (volume level, noise compression, etc.) require more energy than others which depletes the battery more quickly.

Sound Tubes

Tweak Enhance comes with two standard sound tubes (size 2B, left and right). Tubes are marked with red lettering for the right ear and blue lettering for the left ear.

There are a variety of domes/tips included with your hearing aid. The sleeve tip will work for most users. However, for more bass sound use a vented or closed dome.



Choosing the Proper Dome/Tip

When choosing the proper dome/tip, the goal is to get a fit that is comfortable and secure enough to keep domes/tip in the ear. Larger domes will create a more snug fit and increase the bass sounds (lower frequencies) and reduce feedback.

Domes/Tips	Description
Closed dome Closed domes do not have holes in them and are when the hearing aid seems too quiet. They can all to prevent your hearing aids from "whistling" at his volumes.	
Open dome	Open domes have holes in them, to prevent the ears from feeling blocked. This type of dome can help in cases where your own voice seems too loud or the hearing aid seems too noisy.
Sleeve tip	The sleeve tip fits most users. Try it first.





Connecting the Tube and Dome/Tip

- 1 Choose either the left or right sound tube (pictured on page 26).
- 2 Align the sound tube connector end with the sound post on the hearing aid. Twist the tube clockwise onto the sound post until it's snug.
 - **A** Be sure it is securely fastened to the sound tube before inserting it in your ear.
- **3** Choose a dome/tip to use with the sound tube (pictured on page 27).
- 4 Align the dome/tip with the end of the sound tube and push it straight on.





Dome/Tip Insertion Depth

The dome/tip should be completely in the ear canal without touching the eardrum. Proper insertion of the dome/tip is key to getting adequare loudness with no feedback ("whistling").





For adults, the length of the ear canal varies from 0.9" to 1.1". The maximum insertion depth is 0.37". While wearing the hearing aid, the distance from the dome/tip to the eardrum is at least 0.53". This is greater than the lower limit of 0.39" as specified by OTC guidelines, meaning there is more space between the dome/tip and eardrum.



1 Place Tweak Enhance over your ear. The curve of the sound tube should rest on top of your ear comfortably, even with glasses.



2 Grab the loose end of the tubing and gently insert the tip into the ear canal.





4 When properly inserted, the tubing will lay close to the head around the front of the ear and into the ear canal. Check this by moving your finger down the tubing, into the ear.





If the tip doesn't stay in your ear, you may need a different length sound tube. Additional sizes are available at **tweakhearing.com** or by calling **1-888-815-3240**.





Turning ON and OFF

To turn ON, press and hold the **upper portion** of the rocker switch until you hear a beep (approx. 3 seconds) then release. While you are holding the rocker switch, it will turn green. The green light will turn off once the hearing aid is ON.

To turn OFF, again press and hold the **upper portion** of the rocker switch until you hear a beep (approx. 3 seconds) then release. While you are holding the rocker switch, it will turn blue. The blue light will turn off once the hearing aid is OFF.

to turn ON or OFF



Also, the hearing aids will automatically power OFF once they are seated properly in the charging base. However, after removing the hearing aids from the base it will be necessary to power them ON using the rocker switch.

ON —

rocker switch will flash green; power is ON



OFF rocker switch will flash blue then shut OFF





Once setup is complete, every time you turn on your Tweak Enhance, it will revert to the last program and volume setting you used.





Memory Switch

When the hearing instrument is turned ON, it will revert to the last program and volume setting.

To switch programs, press and hold the **lower portion** of the rocker switch for two seconds then release. Do the same to switch to the other programs.

Cleaning the Exterior

1 You should inspect and clean your Tweak Enhance every day. To clean, gently wipe the surface with a soft, dry cloth or a moist non-alcohol disinfecting wipe. Do not allow water or liquid to enter any openings.

The daily use of a DryBoost UV** appliance is

recommended to reduce moisture and wax buildup.








Cleaning the Tip and Tube

1 Remove the sound tube from the case by unscrewing the tube connector from the sound post (turning counterclockwise).

2 Wipe the exterior of the tube and tip.

3 Thread the cleaning line through the tube connector and out of the tip. Wipe end of line and repeat as necessary to remove moisture and debris from the tube.



4 Re-attach the sound tube by aligning the connector end with the sound post on the hearing aid case then turn the tube connector clockwise onto the sound post until snug.



Changing the Tube and Tip

The tube and tip should be changed periodically, typically two or three times per year. When the tube or tip become soft, discolored, kinked, or damaged, the tube can break and become detached from the device. Obtain replacements by calling 1-888-815-3240 or visiting tweakhearing.com



When you change the dome/tip, make sure it is securely fastened to the sound tube before inserting it in your ear.

Extended Storage

If it is necessary to store your Tweak Enhance hearing aid for an extended amount of time, follow these steps:

- 1 Clean your Tweak Enhance according to instructions in the Care section of this manual
- **2** A full cycle in a DryBoost UV* appliance is recommended prior to extended storage.



DryCaddy Disc



3 Place Tweak Enhance in an airtight container with a desiccant such as a Dry-Brik* or DryCaddy® Disc*. Store in a cool dry place.

While in storage, we recommend charging the hearing aids every six months to maintain battery charge.

enhance tips



Place your Tweak Enhance hearing aid in a DryBoost UV drying appliance every night to remove moisture and prevent corrosion. DryBoost UV also sanitizes to remove common germs and viruses from the hearing aid plus recharge the battery!

Safely store Tweak Enhance when not in use. Keep out of reach of small children and pets. In particular, dogs may be irritated by the feedback ("whistling") sound and attracted by the owner's scent. This often results in a chewed and/or ingested device.



Don't leave Tweak Enhance near a stove, in a sunny window, in a car or in any other hot place. Excessive heat or cold can damage the instrument.

Don't wear Tweak Enhance when using a hair dryer or when at the beauty salon, spa or barber.

Don't apply hair spray when wearing your Tweak Enhance. It can damage the microphone or other components.

Don't wear Tweak Enhance while taking a bath, shower, or while swimming.

Don't store Tweak Enhance in the bathroom during a shower or near a steam room, as moisture created by the steam may cause damage.

troubleshooting

No Sound or Not Loud Enough

Make sure the tip is not clogged.

Fully charge the battery.

Make sure the hearing aid case and sound tube are clean and dry. (Refer to page 51.)

Make sure that the hearing aid case is positioned correctly behind the ear, and that the tip is positioned properly in the ear canal.

Make sure the volume is turned up, by tapping the upper portion of the rocker switch.

Excessive ear wax can prevent sound from entering the ear. Contact your physician.

Changes in your hearing can affect how you hear with Tweak Enhance. Contact a hearing healthcare professional if you suspect any change in your hearing condition.

Your Tweak Enhance may need to be reset. See page 44 for instructions. Follow prompts on the screen to set up the hearing aid.

Whistling ("feedback")

Your Tweak Enhance has a best-in-class feedback management system. However, when your hand is near the device, you may hear a whistling noise, which is called "feedback." This may be caused by amplified sound bouncing off your hand back into the instrument. The noise usually quits when you take your hand away.

If the whistling doesn't stop once you've moved your hand away, ensure that the hearing aid case is positioned correctly behind the ear, and that the tip is positioned properly in the ear canal.

Try adjusting the volume. Tap the lower portion of the rocker switch to decrease the volume.

Make sure the dome/tip and sound tube are not clogged with wax or other debris. (Refer to page 52.)

Try adjusting the equalizer via the Enhance app – decrease the higher frequencies.

If the above fails to reduce feedback, contact Tweak for assistance at 1-888-815-3240.

Sound is Distorted, Unclear, Intermittent or has Static Noise

Make sure the tube and tip are not clogged. (Refer to page 52.)

Make sure the hearing aid is clean and dry. We recommend nightly use of a DryBoost UV appliance to remove moisture and prevent corrosion.

If you are near an electromagnetic field (e.g. near a computer screen or fluorescent lights), step away to see if the static clears.

Your Tweak Enhance may need to be reset. See page 44 for instructions. Follow prompts on the screen to set up the hearing aid.

If problem persists, contact Tweak for assistance at 1-888-815-3240.

warranty and service-north america

The manufacturer's warranty period is 12 months.

This warranty covers any defect in material or faulty production, specifically excluding batteries, tips, and tubes. Any and all warranties are invalidated if the Tweak OTC hearing aid has been tampered with or altered in any way, if the serial number has been altered or removed, or if any repairs have been made without authorization. The manufacturer reserves the right to repair or replace the instrument or any defective part, at manufacturer's expense, within the limits of the warranty.

This warranty does not include a promise of specific listening improvement.

Warranty service must only be performed by the manufacturer. Service performed by any unauthorized personnel voids all warranties. If service is needed, contact Tweak Hearing by calling 1-888-815-3240.

repairs and replacements

If your Tweak OTC hearing aid needs to be repaired or replaced during the warranty period, please contact us to arrange a return.

We will accept any Tweak OTC hearing aid for repair/service for a period of one (1) year after the date of purchase. Servicing or replacement after the warranty period has expired will be your responsibility.


